

GST for Common man

Most food items of common use attract either 0% or 5% rate under GST.



If, Unpacked/ Unbranded Items GST @ 0%

▶▶ Chena or Paneer ▶▶ Natural Honey ▶▶ Wheat and Meslin ▶▶ Rye ▶▶ Barley
 ▶▶ Oats ▶▶ Maize (Corn) ▶▶ Rice
 ▶▶ Grain Sorghum ▶▶ Buckwheat, Millet and Canary seeds, other cereals such as Jawar, Bajra, Ragi ▶▶ Wheat or Meslin Flour ▶▶ Cereal Flour other than of Wheat or Meslin ▶▶ Cereal Groats, Meal and Pellets ▶▶ Potatoes Flour
 ▶▶ Dried Leguminous Vegetables (Shelled) i.e. Pulses ▶▶ Dried Makhana ▶▶ Frozen Sweet Potato and similar roots and tubers.

If, Packed/ Branded Items GST @ 5%

Packed and Branded Items mean items put up in unit container and, (a) bearing a registered brand name; or (b) bearing a brand name on which an actionable claim or enforceable right in a court of law is available [other than those where any actionable claim or enforceable right in respect of such brand name has been foregone voluntarily], subject to the prescribed conditions*.
